The workshop and plenary sessions on Thursday and Friday will take place in “Het Pand” in the historic centre of Ghent. The workshop tracks will have an applied and hands-on approach.

The Thursday workshop themes are related to EU feed legislation, equine ration calculation and poisonous plants. The plenary sessions on Thursday and Friday will consist of the following main topics: “Fiber First!” (Friday), “Tools & Techniques in Equine Nutrition & Health” (Friday) including a session dedicated to the “The Internet Connected Horse” (Friday afternoon).
